1. Please provide a description of your request.

The request consists of wireless and wired audio equipment for media production purposes, as well as replacement parts for damaged sets of equipment. The wireless equipment will both replace damaged sets and expand the equipment base, allowing more production teams to film simultaneously. The wired audio equipment will allow teams to produce audio-only productions without use of the wireless audio equipment, which is the only means of providing clear audio while filming video. The replacement parts will restore currently damaged equipment sets to full functionality while also keeping replacement parts on hand in the event of future need.

The audio equipment is easy to use and works with school iPads, student Chromebooks, and teacher Chromebooks and MacBooks, and can be (and has been in the past) utilized by the music department and other extracurricular clubs as well as individual teachers for producing their own multimedia projects as needed.

We appreciate the PTO's generosity and consideration in regards to the equipment, as we are very excited to have nearly doubled WSRS Studios' regular attendance compared to last school year, with many of the students interested in producing a multitude of projects in different formats simultaneously. The scope of the club has also expanded considerably, with a number of projects in the pipeline intended for the school channels. At the moment, the club is down to utilizing one set of wireless microphones compatible with the school iPads, which are used for the majority of the club's video production, as well as two sets of wireless microphones currently suffering from damage to a small component that renders them able to only be used with student Chromebooks, which provide insufficient video quality for most video production and thus can only be used for audio production. The replacement adapters described in the request address this issue directly and would restore these latter two sets to full functionality.

The listed equipment will allow WSRS Studios to add continue servicing all of these goals and allowing the students to realize their creative passions and media endeavors to the fullest, while enhancing the production value of the student work and allowing the scope of the club to continue growing.
